Tip

Measurements Approx 4" x 68" (10 x 173 cm)

The long skinny scarf is the easiest and most versatile accessory. So fun to crochet, you can make one in several colors.

Abbreviations:

beg = beginning

ch = chain stitch

rep = repeat

rs = right side

sc = single crochet

yoh = yarn over hook

Instructions


Chain (ch) 14.

1st row: Right side (rs). 1 single crochet (sc) in 2nd chain from hook. 1 single crochet in each chain across. Turn. 13 single crochet in total.


2nd row: Chain (ch) 1. 1 single crochet in each single crochet from previous row. Turn.

Repeat last row until work from beginning (beg) measures 68" (173 cm) long. Fasten off.

Chain Stitch (ch)



1 Yarn over hook (yoh) and draw the yarn through to form a new loop without tightening up the previous one.



2 Repeat to form as many chains (ch) as required. Do not count the slip knot as a stitch.

Remember
to start each
row with chain 1.
This creates the height
needed to work each
new row of single
crochet.

Single Crochet (sc)







- 1 Insert the hook into the work [2nd chain (ch) from hook on starting chain], *yarn over hook (yoh) and draw yarn through the work only.
- **2** Yarn over hook (yoh) again and draw the yarn through both loops on the hook.
- **3** 1 single crochet (sc) made. Insert hook into next chain: repeat (rep) from * in step 1.

Fasten Off



Fasten off by cutting working yarn approx 6" (15 cm) long and draw this end through last loop. Pull tightly to secure.
