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Knit Scarf

This lacy and lovely scarf is created using simple knit and purl stitches. Make several to coordinate with your spring wardrobe.

Stitches Used:

Knit, Purl

Size: One size to fit average adult.

Finished Measurements:

Approx 5 ¼" x 66" (13 x 167.5 cm).

Supplies:

- 1 Ball Loops and Threads Impeccable Amethyst or color of your choice
- Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles
- Yarn needle

Gauge:

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stocking st.

Abbreviations:

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ing)

Cont = Continue

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern

P = Purl

Pssso = Pass slipped stitch over

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over



Knit Scarf Instructions

Cast on 26 sts.

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Proceed in Lace Pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K3.

Rep from * to last 4 sts. P2. K2.

2nd row: K2. *K2. P3. Rep from * to last 4 sts. K4.

3rd row: K2. *P2. yo. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. yo. Rep from * to last 4 sts. P2. K2.

4th row: Rep 2nd row.

Rep last 4 rows for Lace Pat until work from beg measures approx 65" (165 cm), ending on a 4th row.

Knit 5 rows (garter st).

Cast off knitwise (WS). Weave in ends.

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Tip:

Yarn overs create spaces in your knitting, giving the fabric a lacy appearance.
