

# Vanna's Choice Arm Knit Shawl

## Supplies:

- Lion Brand Vanna's Choice
  - 1 Ball – Barley (A)
  - 1 Ball – Linen (B)
  - 1 Ball – Beige (C)
  - 1 Ball – Chocolate (D)
  - 1 Ball – Black (E)
- or colors of your choice

Beginner / Débutante / Novicecia



## SHAWL

With 1 strand each of A, B, C, D and E (5 strands total) cast on 17 stitches following the **Basic Arm Knitting Instructions**. Arm knit until piece measures about 35 in. (89 cm) from beginning. Bind off.

## FINISHING

Thread each yarn end into blunt needle, then weave through stitches. With sewing needle and thread, sew button to any corner of Shawl.

## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- Yarn needle
- Sewing needle and thread
- One large button

## GAUGE:

Gauge is not important for this project.

## NOTES

1. Arm knitting is a fun, fast technique that creates a wonderfully open fabric using only your arms! The openness of the fabric can be altered by how tight or loose you choose to make your stitches.
2. The Shawl is arm knit as a simple rectangle with 5 strands of yarn held together.
3. A button is sewn onto the completed Shawl.
