# Crochet Coasters

*Add a touch of color to your tabletop and protect it too with these quick and easy coasters. They make great housewarming gifts too!*

## Stitches Used:

Chain stitch, Double crochet

## Finished Measurements:

Approx 4" (10 cm) in diameter.

## Supplies:

- 1 Ball – Bernat Handicrafter Cotton ROBINS EGG (or your choice of color)
- 1 Ball – Bernat Handicrafter Cotton HOT GREEN (or your choice of color)
- 1 Ball – Bernat Handicrafter Cotton TANGERINE (or your choice of color)
- 1 Ball – Bernat Handicrafter Cotton PALE YELLOW (or your choice of color)
- 1 Ball – Bernat Handicrafter Cotton SAGE GREEN (or your choice of color)
- Size H-8 (5mm) Crochet Hook
- Yarn Needle

## Gauge:

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" (10 cm).

## Abbreviations:

**Approx** = Approximately

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sp** = Space

**Sts** = Stitch(es)



## Tip:

This coaster pattern is a basic granny square motif. Once you master crocheting in the round, experiment with changing colors in different rounds.

## Instructions

Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

**1st rnd:** Ch 3 (counts as dc).

17 dc in ring. Join with sl st to top of ch-3 – 18 dc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 6 (counts as 1 dc and ch-3 sp). 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. Skip next 2 dc.

\*(1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) in next dc. Ch 1.

Skip next 2 dc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-6.

**3rd rnd:** Sl st in first ch-3 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 6 dc in same sp as last sl st. \*7 dc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Repeat pattern instructions to create as many 4" (10 cm) coasters as needed.
